

Dear Mr. Chris Ayers/Debo,

I heard that there is a hearing, although I've seen no documentation, scheduled for July 1, 2015 at the General Sessions Court in Murfreesboro, TN and I assume my attendance is required, . . . and I have no idea where and the time. Since I have not been notified by you or the prosecutor in this case, Mr. Brent Lindsay Pierce, as to the scheduled hearing, let this letter commemorate that fact and my uninformed understanding as to the court schedule and my required attendance.

I was **NOT** notified by Norton Bonding of a hearing in April, 2015, at which my attendance was apparently required. The Rutherford County Sheriff's two-man "Fugitive/Dangerous Major Felons squad" headed up by Jack Keisling and Randy Morrow, was sent to retrieve me. They found me **hiding at my place of work** at Discount Tires, located at 909 Old Fort Parkway, Murfreesboro, TN. Again without due process, I was incarcerated and held for ransom for the second time.

Is this, or am I being set up for another "sting," "Operation Falcon," "Premeditated Murder" as was the recent Lynchburg, TN, Musician Randy Howard on Tuesday night, June 9th, 2015. A Plus Bail Bonding company sent out a "bounty hunter," Jackie Shell, trying to detain Mr. Howard who was **found hiding at his house, shot and killed Mr. Howard** – as he was deemed to have "**missed a court appearance**"! I fear you are attempting to perform the very same scenario with me. Tell me I am wrong or misinformed. It is impossible for me to think otherwise, since Mr. Brent Lindsay Pierce, (or anyone else for that matter working for the entire Rutherford County Court System in Murfreesboro, TN), **has NEVER communicated anything to me** since the inception of the case, including notification of any hearings. He refuses to honor his Oath of Office in Rutherford County Tennessee as does everyone acting in concert with him.

I'm no Sherlock Holmes and I don't believe it takes forensic or astute logical reasoning here, but I'm seeing a pattern here in Tennessee.

Order frees 13 inmates held for unpaid fees

Judge: Nonpayment is not a probation violation

MURFREESBORO — Heather Keller is looking forward to spending Christmas with her children after a federal judge's order set her free from the Rutherford County Detention Center Friday afternoon.

A day earlier, a federal judge in Nashville granted an injunction that prevented officials and probation supervisors in Rutherford County from holding people in jail for certain violations or only because they could not pay fees. It also said that anyone being held for those reasons should be let go.

Keller, 35, was one of 13 inmates released from the jail in Murfreesboro who were held there because they could not pay fees to the private company contracted to oversee the Rutherford County misdemeanor probation system.

The injunction that won Keller's release was part of a lawsuit filed against Providence Community Corrections, which has changed its name to Pathways Community Corrections.

The suit was filed in October and accuses Rutherford County and PCC

of working together to extort people on probation there by charging excessive fees. Many of the seven people named in the lawsuit rely on government assistance and have said in court testimony or documents that PCC's excessive fees leave them struggling to pay bills and facing extended probation terms because they cannot pay court costs.

It is a practice Alec Karakatsanis, attorney for the plaintiffs, likens to the operation of a debtors' prison.

Karakatsanis said Sharp's order is only the beginning of possible probation reform in Rutherford County.

what we believe to be the rise of a modern debtors' prison system in which the poor and destitute are jailed and threatened with jail solely because of their inability to make monetary payments to a private company and their local government," Karakatsanis said. "This is a very important ruling for impoverished people in Tennessee."

The injunction was granted by Chief District Judge Kevin Sharp in Nashville. In addition to freeing these prisoners, Sharp also ordered PCC immediate-

ly stop the practice of violating probationers solely for nonpayment of fees.

Keller was originally arrested for driving on a suspended license and since has been jailed twice for nonpayment of probation fees, she said.

"I've spent more time in jail for non-payment than the original charge," Keller said.

Sharp also ordered Rutherford County Sheriff Robert Arnold to free any inmates held on violation of probation charges stemming solely from nonpayment of fees and fines.

On Friday, in compliance with Sharp's injunction, General Sessions Judge Ben Hall McFarlin Jr. and Barry Tidwell issued a general order declaring any probationers serving time for nonpayment in Rutherford County to be released.

They will still be required to show up

in court for their cases or risk being sent back to jail, Arnold reminded Keller and others released Friday.

Officials from the Sheriff's Office have said previously that about one-fifth of the jail's inmates are being held on charges from PCC. The jail has a maximum capacity of 958.

Keller had spent three days in jail when she received news of her unexpected early release, but on Friday she was only looking to the future.

"Just knowing that I can see a smile on my kids' faces is what matters to me," Keller, the mother of a 3- and a 5-year-old, said as she left the jail.
